IMPORTANT! READ THESE POINTS BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- "TEST FIT" all parts before cementing.
 Trim excess plastic from parts before joining.
- Cement all parts unless otherwise indicated by the instructions.
- 3 Use paint and cement made for styrene plastic only.
- Paint all sub-assemblies before attaching chrome parts.
- 5 Scrape chrome and paint away from surfaces to be cemented together.
- Follow all of the numbers on the instruction sheet beginning with number one.
