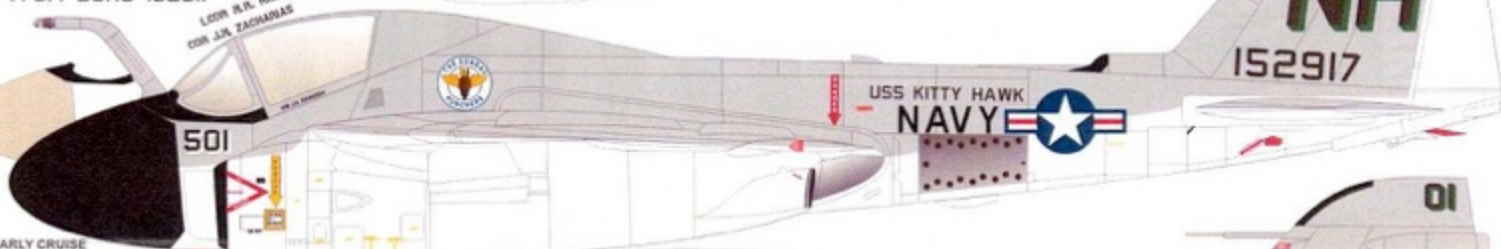

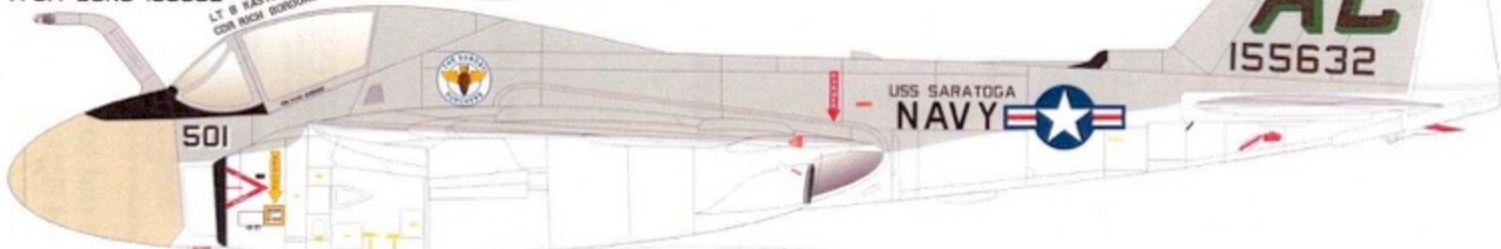

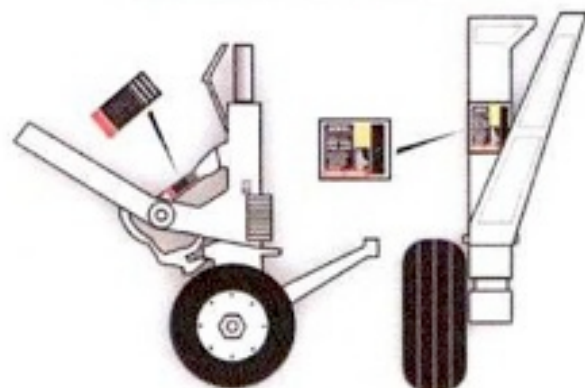
UNDERWING NATIONAL INSIGNIA  
PLACED FURTHER OUTBOARD

THE ORIGINAL A-6As WERE DELIVERED WITH BLACK  
RADOMES AND THEY FLEW THIS WAY FOR SEVERAL YEARS.  
IT WAS FOUND OVER VIETNAM THAT THE BLACK NOSE STOOD  
OUT AND MADE A BIGGER TARGET FOR GROUND GUNNERS.  
By 1968 MOST SQUADRONS HAD TRANSITIONED TO  
RADOME TAN. IT WAS ALSO A THOUGHT AT THE TIME THAT  
THE BLACK NOSES HEATED THE RADAR COMPONENTS.

PRIOR TO 1969, BOARDING LADDERS  
WERE PAINTED WHITE. POST 1969,  
THEY WERE PAINTED RED.

SEAT CUSHION AND HEADBOX.
