Notes on the Drawings

The preceding illustrations are intended to show only basic camouflage and markings placement information. Due to the limited nature of quality photography of many of these aircraft, we have not attempted to portray the definitive and precise camouflage patterns applied to them. Also, the individual's interpretation of photographs or drawings can cause wide variation in what the "exact" pattern or colors are perceived to be. We highly encourage you to avail yourself of as many references for the particular aircraft you wish to model as possible.

National insignias are not included in all cases, however those required for the Bf-109s and Fw-190s illustrated may be obtained from AeroMaster sheets 48-019 through 48-024. Unless otherwise indicated, all national insignias are "standard" for the type as supplied in the above sets.

Bf-109G-4/R6, W.Nr. 14997 (ex KJ+GU), 7./JG52, Russia, May 1943. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with lower wingtips, lower cowling and rear fuselage band in RLM 04 yellow. Spinner 1/3 white and 2/3 RLM 70. Note underwing 20mm cannon gondolas. Paint yellow fuselage band, apply black decals 2 & 3, then apply white winkels (6) as shown. Fuselage crosses filled with RLM 74. Heavy exhaust staining.



Bf-109G-6, W.Nr. 20499, 9./JG52, Russia, October 1943. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with lower wingtips, forward lower cowling and partial rear fuselage band in RLM 04 yellow. Spinner 1/3 white and 2/3 RLM 70. Fuselage crosses unfilled allowing camouflage beneath to show through. Note missing ADF loop antenna.

Maj. Gerhard Barkhorn

- Bf-109F-4, 4./JG52, Russia, spring 1942. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with RLM 04 yellow cowling and rear fuselage band. Spinner RLM 70, probably with 1/3 white. Note armored windscreen.
- Bf-109G-6, II./JG52, Russia, September 1943. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with lower wingtips and rear fuselage band in RLM 04 yellow. Spinner black with white spiral. Fuselage crosses filled with RLM 74.

Maj. Gunther Rall

- Bf-109G-2, 8./JG52, Russia, September 1943. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with RLM 04 yellow lower wingtips and rear fuselage band. Fuselage heavily mottled with a dark color, probably RLM 70. Spinner RLM 70, probably with 1/3 white. Fuselage crosses filled with RLM 74.
- Bf-109G-6, III./JG52, Russia, March 1944. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with lower wingtips and rear fuselage band RLM 04 yellow. Spinner black with white spiral. Fuselage crosses filled with RLM 74.

Oblt. Otto Kittel

Fw-190A-5, W.Nr. 550529, 1./JG54, Kurland, November 1944. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with RLM 04 yellow lower wingtips and fuselage band. Spinner RLM 70 (or black) with white spiral. Exhaust panel black.

Maj. Malter Nowotny

- Bf-109F-4, 1./JG54, Russia, July 1942. RLM 70/02/79/76 camouflage scheme. Exact pattern not known, but similar to other JG54 aircraft. See references.
- Me-262A-1a, W.Nr. 110400, Kommando Nowotny, Achmer, Germany, November 1944. RLM 81/82 (or 83)/76 camouflage with tail heavily overpainted with areas of 76 and 81. Jet intakes RLM 04 yellow.

Maj. Frich Rudorffer

Bf-109F-4, W.Nr. 7650, 6./JG2, France, September 1941. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with RLM 04 yellow rudder. Spinner 2/3 RLM 70 and 1/3 white. Wing root areas painted black to hide exhaust stains. Note armored windscreen.

Obstlt. Heinz Bar

- Bf-109E-3, W.Nr. 3714, 1./JG51, Pihen, France, September 1940. RLM 71/02/65 camouflage scheme with spinner in RLM 70.
- Fw-190A-7, W.Nr. 172689, II./JG1, Störmede, Germany, April 1944. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage with black spinner and exhaust area.

Bf-109E-7/N, 9./JG52, Russia, summer 1941. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with cowling, spinner, lower wingtips and aft fuselage band in RLM 04 yellow.

Bf-109G-6, W.Nr. 15919, J.Gr.50, Wiesbaden-Erbenheim, Germany, September 1943. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with RLM 04 yellow lower cowling and white vertical tail surfaces. Fuselage crosses filled with RLM 74. Note that the Werke Nummer is on a camouflaged background. Paint spinner red to match tulips petals.

Maj. Theodore Meissenberger

- Bf-109G-2/R6, 7./JG5, Petsamo, Finland, July 1943. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with RLM 04 yellow lower wingtips. Spinner white.
- Me-262A-1a, Geschwader Kommodore/JG7, Brandenberg-Briest, Germany, February 1945. RLM 81/82 (or 83)/76 camouflage scheme with blotches of RLM 76 on fuselage sides and tail. RLM 04 yellow RVD band, partly overpainted with RLM 82 or 83.

Gbstlt. Hans Philipp

- Bf-109E-3, 4./JG54, France, October 1940. RLM 71/02/65 camouflage scheme with cowling and rudder in RLM 04 yellow. Spinner 2/3 RLM 70 and 1/3 white with white tip.
- Bf-109F-2, 6./JG54, Russia, July 1941. Upper surfaces RLM 74/75 camouflage. Fuselage sides are RLM 76 with RLM 71 streaks and RLM 02 blotches. Lower surfaces are RLM 76.

Maj. Heinrich Ehrler

- Bf-109F-4, 6./JG5, Petsamo, Finland, July 1942. Upper surfaces RLM 70 and 75, lower surfaces RLM 76. Exact upper surface pattern not known. Lower cowling and 1/2 of spinner RLM 04 yellow, remainder of spinner RLM 70.
- Bf-109G-2/R6, 6./JG5, Petsamo, Finland, March 1943. Upper surfaces oversprayed white with RLM 70 blotches. Rudder RLM 04 yellow. Lower surfaces, including lower cowling panels RLM 76. Fuselage crosses filled with RLM 74. Spinner white.

Oblt. Anton Hafner

Bf-109G-2, 4./JG51, Orel, Russia, August 1942. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage scheme with RLM 04 yellow rear fuselage band. Spinner RLM 70, probably with 1/3 white. Fuselage crosses filled with RLM 75.
