Note: use templates provided for painting interior part of fuselage crosses RLM 74.

Russia, late 1942. Camouflage is RLM 74 Graugrūn &
RLM 75 Grauviolett over RLM 76 Lichtblau. Lower

yellow. Spinner is RLM 70 Dunkelgrūn. Mottling
appears to be RLM 74 and 75. Note heavy exhaust
stains on fuselage sides.







Bf109G-2 74/75/76 camouflage pattern















